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## Objective

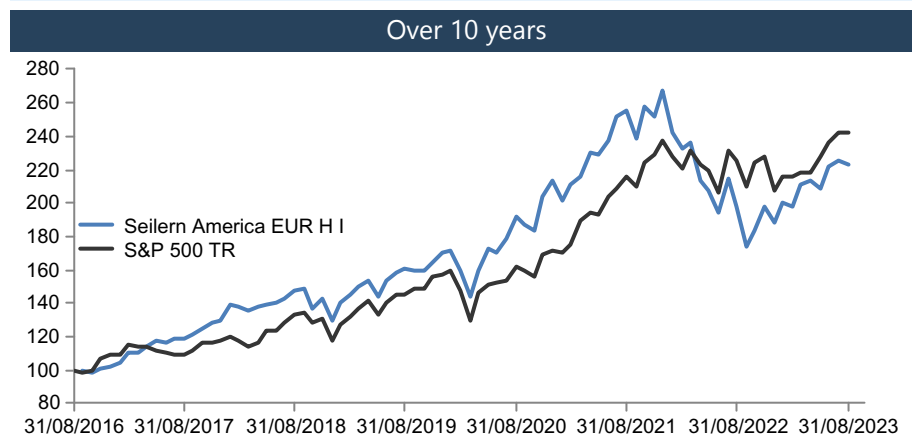
## Commentary

West Pharmaceutical Services was the best performer, up +10.6%. The stock rose on positive news of favourable trial outcomes for wider use cases of obesity-related drugs, where West helps to manufacture the delivery device components. Mastercard was second best, up +4.7%. There was little news on the company except for an announcement of a planned fee increase later this year, on the 30th August. Estée Lauder was the worst performer, down -10.8%. The company reported Q4 results ahead of expectations but disappointed yet again on its fiscal Q1 guidance. They now expect greater than anticipated pressure on Asia travel retail due to the Daigou crackdown. Nike was the second-worst performer, down -7.9%. Shares fell after a host of results from large wholesale partners such as Dick's Sporting Goods and Footlocker, which painted a disappointing picture of the US consumer.

In the United Kingdom it is a recognised scheme under s.264 Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 with the Financial Conduct Authority.

Seilern International AG ("SIAG") is the management company and distributor for the Fund. Seilern Investment Management Ltd. ("SIM") is the investment manager to the Fund.

### Definitions:

The Seilern America EUR H I fund is actively managed and uses the S&P 500 TR as the benchmark index against which the Fund's performance is compared. The S&P 500 is an equity benchmark that represents the performance of the 500 large companies listed in the United States. "TR" stands for total return, and it assumes any cash distributions, including dividends are reinvested. "CAGR" stands for the compound annual growth rate.

The **Ongoing Charges Figure (OCF)** is the total cost of running the Fund, including the cost of marketing, trading and distribution. The OCF is based on the year ending December 2021, and can vary year to year.

### Tax treatment:

Potential investors should consult with their professional advisers in relation to the tax treatment of their holdings. Please note that the dividends/interest which the fund may receive may be subject to withholding taxes. The tax treatment depends on the individual circumstances of each client and may be subject to change in the future.
