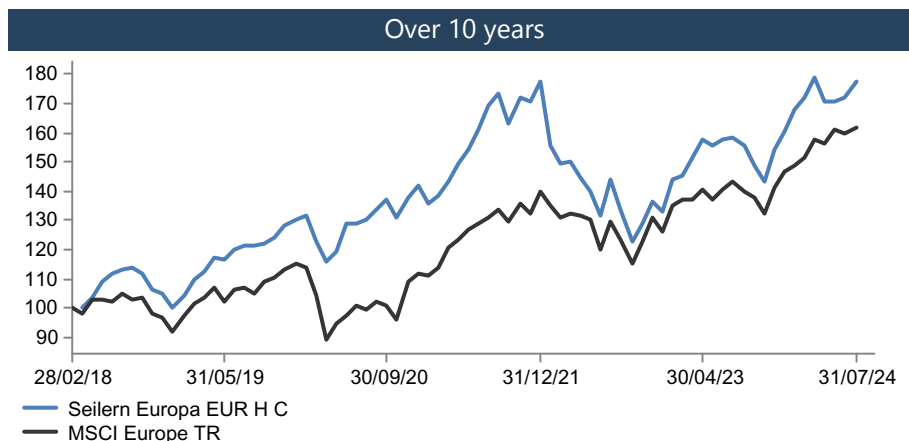
## Commentary

SGS was the best performer, rising +20.13%. The company's H1 results were ahead of expectations and a cost savings plan delivered benefits earlier than expected, both of which were well received. Lonza was second best, up +19.78%. The company reported strong H1 results, with the biologics and small molecules divisions driving a margin beat, paving the way for a potential upgrade to guidance in the second half. Novo Nordisk was the worst performer this month down -9.31%. The stock reacted negatively to the prospect of increasing competition in the obesity space after the positive outcome from Roche's GLP-1 trial for the treatment of obesity. Hermès was the second worst, down -5.17%. The stock was hit following negative consumer data coming from China as well as by the disappointing results from several companies that operate in the luxury space.

### Definitions:

The Seilern Europa EUR H C fund is actively managed and uses the MSCI Europe TR as the benchmark index against which the Fund's performance is compared'. The MSCI Europe Index is an equity benchmark that represents large and mid-cap equity performance across 15 developed markets countries in Europe. "TR" stands for total return, and it assumes any cash distributions, including dividends are reinvested. "CAGR" stands for the compound annual growth rate.

The **Ongoing Charges Figure (OCF)** is the total cost of running the Fund, including the cost of marketing, trading and distribution. The OCF is based on December month end 2023, and can vary year to year.
